

1 AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO CONTROLLING UNDESIRABLE ACTIVITIES IN
2 THE VICINITY OF LICENSED TAVERNS

4 NOW, THEREFORE,

5
6 The Town Board of the Town of Bristol does hereby ordain as follows:

7
8 FINDINGS. The Town Board finds that taverns licensed for the sale of alcohol
9 beverages have the potential for causing disruption of the privacy and peace of the
10 persons in their immediate vicinity. In order to assure that the operation of taverns does
11 not diminish the property values of adjacent properties or disturb the peace, the Town
12 hereby finds it necessary to adopt the following regulations, which shall be enforced
13 against all licensed establishments based on the extent to which violations occur or may
14 occur, without regard to any activities which occur within such taverns:

15
16 (1) The following prohibitions shall apply to all areas which are located within 1,320 feet
17 of any establishment licensed to sell alcoholic beverages.

19 (a) Public urination or defecation. No person may urinate or defecate
20 other than in a restroom or privy.
- 21 (b) Trespass. No person may be physically present on the property of
22 another without the consent of an owner or person in charge of the
23 property. This shall specifically include driving a motor vehicle
24 into the driveway of a property without the permission of the owner
25 of the property.
- 26 (c) Parking. No person may park a motor vehicle on the property of
27 another. No person may park a motor vehicle on any portion of a
28 Town road designated and posted as a no-parking zone by the Town
29 Board unless the person is the owner, occupant or guest of a
30 residence which immediately abuts the location where the car is
31 parked.
- 32 (d) Annoyance or harassment of individuals in the vicinity. No person
33 may, in a manner which causes or tends to cause a breach of the
34 peace, call out in a loud voice, engage in boisterous conduct, make
35 loud or annoying noises, calls, whistles, screams, or undertake other
36 disruptive actions directed at individuals who reside near or are
37 located near a licensed tavern. This section shall not forbid any
38 conduct which is undertaken to express ideas or artistic matters if
39 such expression does not cause or tend to cause a breach of the
40 peace.
- 41 (e) Loitering. No person may, whether on foot or in a motor vehicle,
42 remain at or near a licensed tavern for the purpose of soliciting
43 sexual gratification for consideration; seeking to purchase, sell or
44 consume unlawful drugs or controlled substances; or in a fashion
45 which disturbs the peace.

46 (2) Penalty. (a) Any person found to be in violation of any provision of this ordinance
47 shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than
48 three hundred dollars (\$300). For a second and subsequent offense within a six (6) month
49 period, the penalty shall be not less than five hundred nor more than two thousand
50 dollars.

52 (b) Each violation of this ordinance shall be considered a separate offense, and any
53 violation continuing more than one day shall be considered a separate offense.

54 (c) Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is deemed invalid or unconstitutional
55 by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect
56 the other provisions of the same.
